

## Regulation Committee

### Terms of Reference

#### General

- To meet 3 – 4 times a year
- To elect a chairperson to sit for 3 years, no longer than 2 terms as chairperson
- To report back to Council to seek approval for decisions made at committee meetings

#### Specific

To liaise with the Care Quality Commission and ensure regulation is fair, reasonable and appropriate to what regulation can achieve.

To assist members where possible in their dealings with the CQC.

To ensure the IDF is indemnified with regard to liaison activity (waiver from doctor).

To arrange a meeting twice a year with the CQC, to discuss contemporary or contentious issues within the regulatory setting.

To liaise with the other committees and assist when necessary in the running of the IDF.
